Agreement Between

**Delaware Department of Natural Resources and Environmental Control,
Delaware Coastal Management Program**

and

US Wind, Inc.


US Wind, Inc. (“US Wind”) has submitted a federal consistency certification to the Delaware Coastal Management Program (DCMP) in addition to the Bureau of Ocean and Energy Management Construction and Operations Plan for an offshore wind energy project approximately 18.5 kilometers off the coast of Maryland on the Outer Continental Shelf (FC 2022.0088). The Coastal Zone Management Act (CZMA) six-month review period began on June 23, 2022, and was to end on December 23, 2022.

The proposed project is subject to DCMP review pursuant to the CZMA, 16 U.S.C. §§ 1451-1466, and the CZMA’s implementing regulations at 15 CFR part 930, subpart E. In accordance with 15 CFR 930.60(b), and in consideration of the parties’ mutual interest that the State have additional time to fully assess the proposed project’s consistency with the state’s enforceable policies, the DCMP and US Wind mutually agree to the following dates and to stay the DCMP CZMA six-month review period as specified herein.

The stay of the six-month review period shall begin on July 23, 2022, and will end on August 9, 2023, at which time the remainder of the six-month review period, 5 months, shall commence. The DCMP will issue its decision on or before January 9, 2024, when the remainder of the six-month review period ends.

The DCMP and US Wind mutually agree that the DCMP may issue its consistency decision during the stay period and before the end of the stay if the DCMP determines it has received sufficient information. Mutual consent is required for revocation or modification (including extension) of the agreement.


We, the undersigned, agree to stay the six-month federal consistency review period as indicated above, beginning on July 23, 2022.
