Tips for Success

- 1 Keep presentations simple. Limit bullet points and text. Avoid excessive animations.
- 2 Use clear, readable fonts such as Calibri, Arial, or Verdana.
- 3 Use large font sizes: 40-point for titles, 32-point for subtitles, minimum 24-point.
- 4 Ensure graphs and charts are easy to read and highlight key information.
