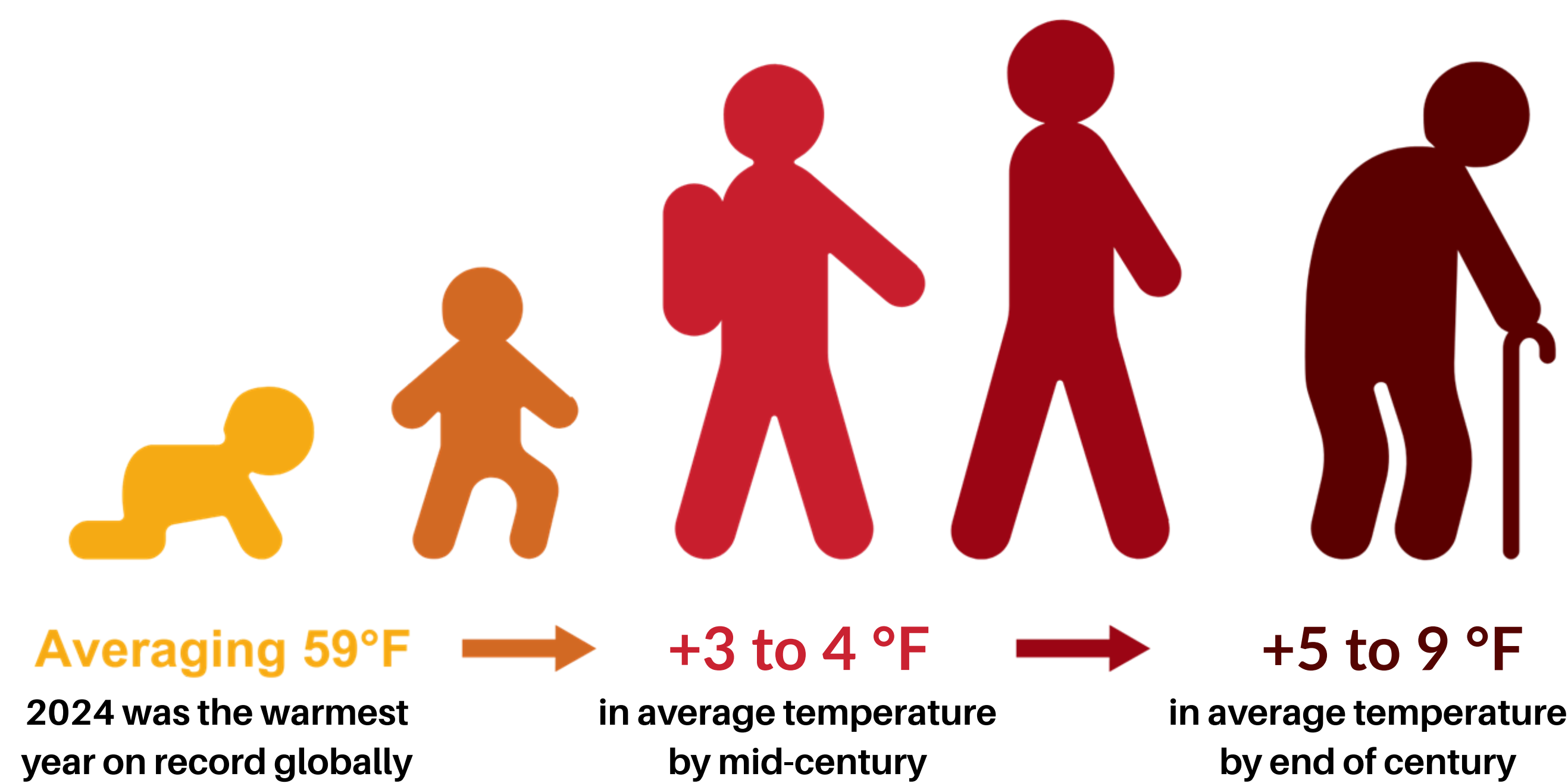


DELAWARE CLIMATE CHANGE IMPACTS

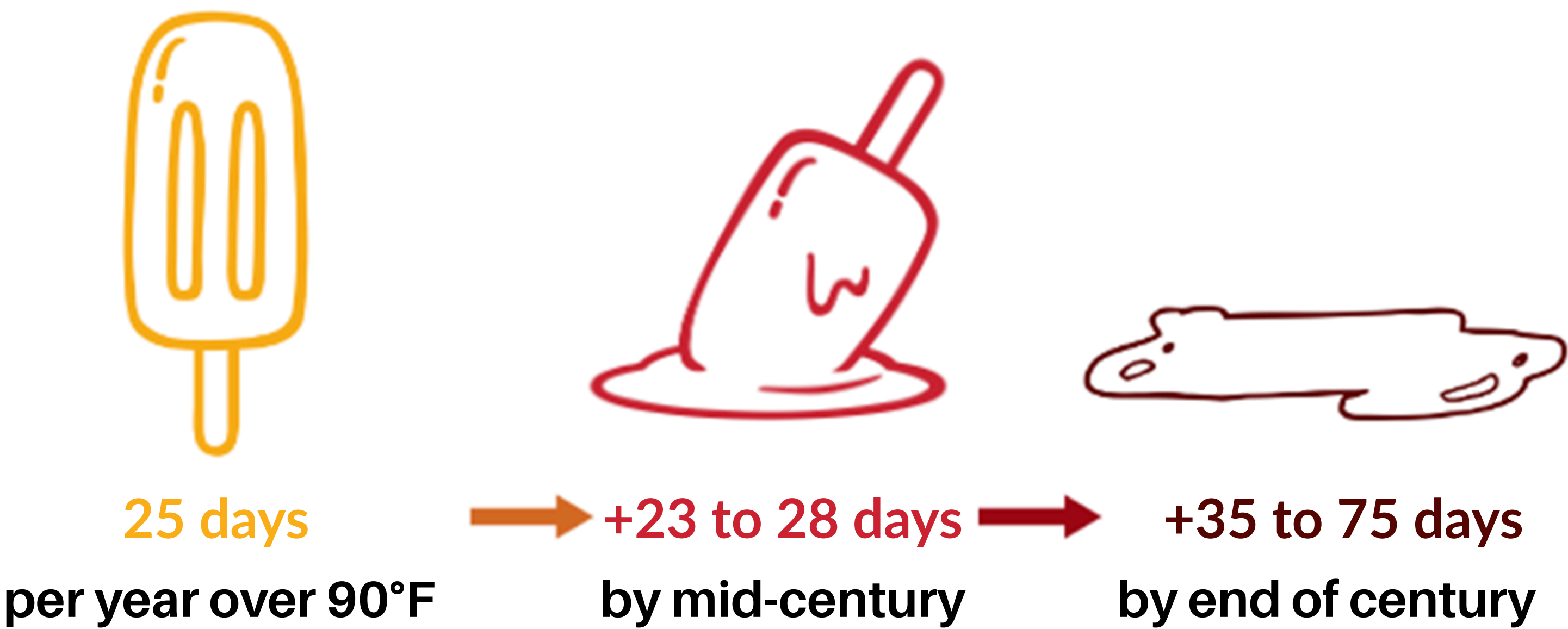


INCREASED TEMPERATURES



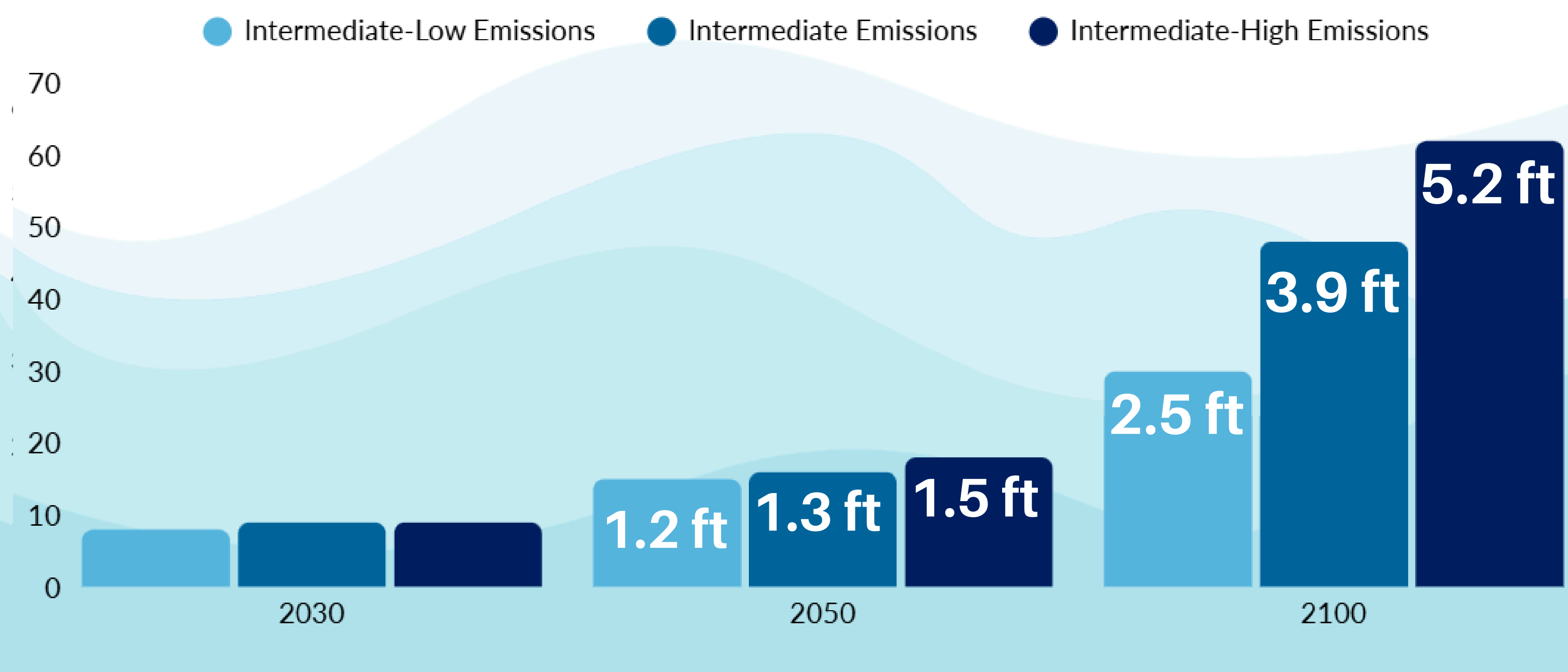
Delaware’s average annual temperatures have risen 3°F since 1900.

HOTTER, LONGER SUMMERS



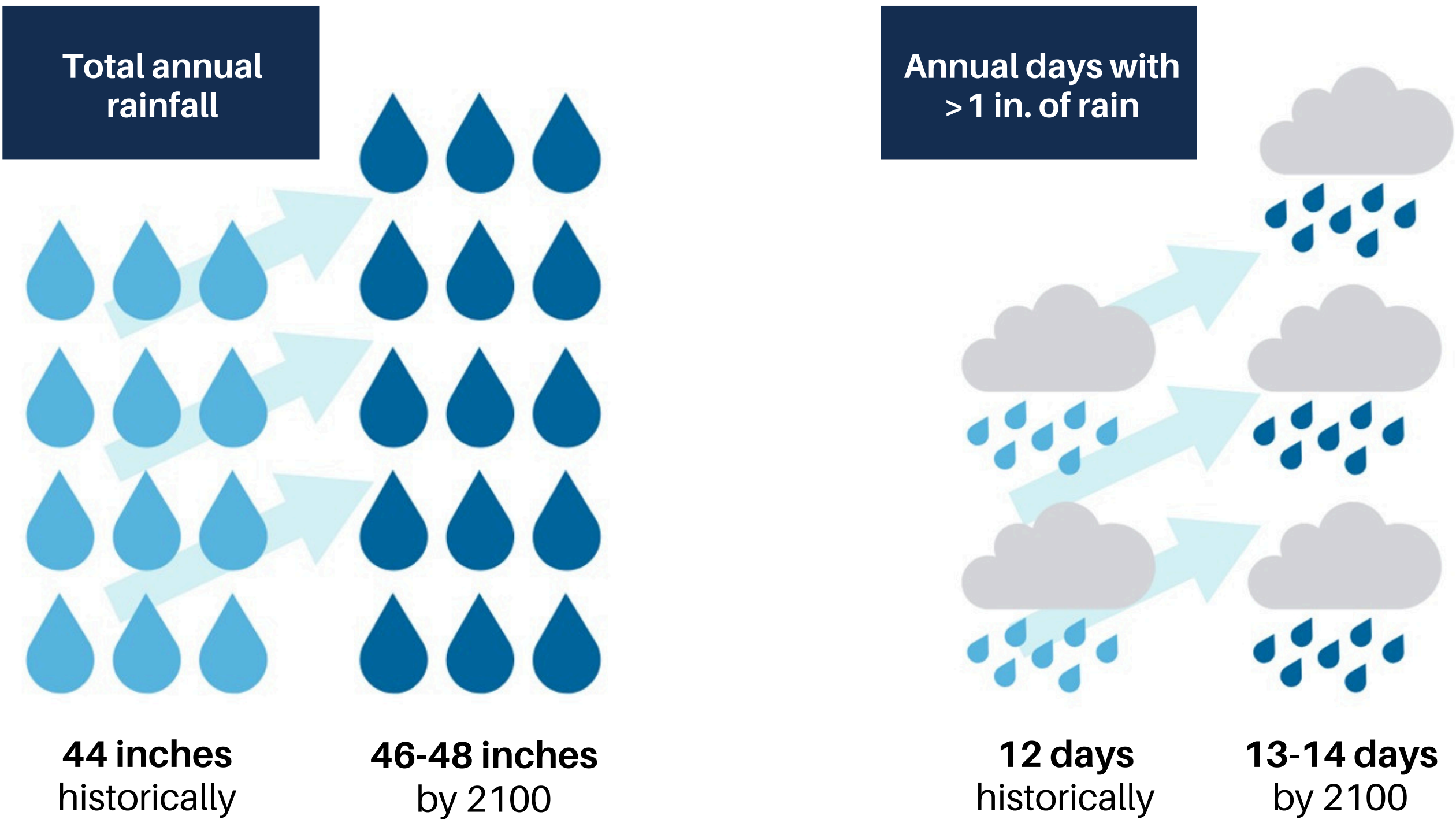
Historically, days over 90°F in Delaware are uncommon, but could become frequent.

RISING SEA LEVELS



Sea levels in Delaware have risen more than a foot over the last century.

INCREASED PRECIPITATION



Delaware averages 44 inches of rain per year, typically evenly distributed among seasons.
