


Introduction





Current Status of DNREC Programs: EEIF

- Program continues to operate with staff working remotely
- Applications for comprehensive, multimeasure projects increased due to new custom grant structure
- Participant impacts:
 - Increased ventilation and "repurposing" of office space
 - Majority of the participants anticipated future investment in EE
- Impact on the EEIF contractors varied





Current Status of DNREC Programs: WAP



Pause of Program Operation in March

- Staff implemented new safety polices
- Program resumed operation in June



Client Intake

- Virtual intake
- Minimal contact, drive-up locations



Auditing and Measure Installation


- Program staff trained contractors on new COVID safety protocols
- Provided PPE to auditors, contractors, and clients
- 17 out of 18 clients agreed to weatherization services



Current Status of DNREC Programs: GEP

- Program continued operating with staff working remotely
- Participants indicated COVID had <u>not</u> affected EE and RE decision-making
- One quarter of surveyed participants plan to participate in DNREC programs in next 12-24 months
- COVID impacts on energy consumption was split

Objective: Learn what other states have done to respond to COVID-19 crisis


Focused on

- Financial assistance


9 Jurisdictions researched, including

- Suspension of service disconnections
- Flexible payment plans

- Deadline extensions
- Additional outreach
- Program suspension (rare)

- Additional outreach
- Temporary incentive increases
- Extended/flexible deadlines
- Free educational resources
- A focus on midstream and upstream

Policy Impacts – 2020 White Papers

We reviewed several energy policy white papers by leading research organizations and think tanks.

Each called for aggressive energy efficiency action as COVID relief and economic stimulus.

- Changes to program requirements
- Suspend regulatory barriers (e.g., cost effectiveness thresholds, accelerated approvals)
- Diversity, equity, and inclusion in program enhancements (e.g., representative workforce)
- Expand funding and eligibility for WAP
- Use energy efficiency as a lever to stimulate the economy while also providing tangible assistance to people in their homes and businesses, advancing green policy, and making progress toward climate change mitigation goals.








Policy Impacts – Congressional COVID Relief Bill

US Congress' COVID relief bill passed in December 2020 included expansion of WAP and green tax credits.

Recommendations – Existing Programs



EEIF

Streamline approvals

- Clearly communicate expectations
- Standardize calculation tools and forms



GEP

Leverage COVID-related home energy use

- Use changes in residential energy use in marketing
- Highlight participant testimonials
- Assist contractor outreach



WAP

Expand WAP Offerings

- Expand eligibility criteria
- Increase subsidies
- Create new community partnerships
- Focus on most vulnerable



Recommendations – New Offerings





- Increased measure incentives
- Home Energy Reports
- On-bill financing
- Free home energy assessments



Small Business Direct Install

- Stimulus to struggling small businesses
- Part of EEIF or separate
- Tailored to small business unique needs
- Little or no out-of-pocket cost to owner



Recommendations – Marketing and Outreach





Increase Marketing and Outreach

- Publicity for WAP
- Direct outreach to C&I
- Increase publicity for the State Energy Program Revolving Loan Fund
- Leverage reduced commercial occupancy in marketing*

Update Website

- New EEIF implementer could support this work
- Clearinghouse for EE and information on financial support:
 - Links to state and federal funding available to business owners
 - Energy efficiency tips
 - Links to resources such as ASHRAE
 - Links to state energy efficiency programs




* Reduced occupancy may present opportunity for upgrades without disruption to workflow

Recommendations – Research

Indoor Air Quality Measures

- Study energy impacts of IAQ
- Assess energy saving potential
- Adjust messaging around IAQ-related incentives to emphasize COVID-era ventilation needs
