Deer Carcass Tag Instructions

A deer carcass tag is required to be affixed to your deer if it is no longer in your immediate possession. If your deer is in your immediate possession, you do not need to affix a carcass tag to the deer. Carcass tags must contain the hunter's name, license/LEN number, harvest date, and registration number if the deer has been registered.

Reminder: You must report your harvest within 24 hours of harvest or before the deer is skinned, dismembered for consumption, or taken to a processor or taxidermist. Register your deer online at <https://de.gov/DigitalDNREC> or by calling 1-855-DEL-HUNT (1-855-335-4868). You will receive a registration number which you must record on your Deer Harvest Report Card (separate document); and on the above exemplified Deer Carcass Tag only if the deer is no longer in your immediate possession.
