

# How to Access and Print Your Deer Damage Assistance Permit

Once your application has been approved you will receive an email with all of your permit documents attached. Typically these documents include a Welcome Letter, Permit, and Harvest Report Card. **All hunters must have both a Permit and Harvest Report Card from the current season in their possession while hunting.**

1. To access your Deer Damage Permit and print your documents you must sign in to your Digital DNREC account.

5. Three (3) documents should start to download. You can access them by clicking on them in the bottom left corner or upper right corner of your screen.

**Caution** Some internet browsers will try to restrict multiple files from being downloaded at once. In this event a pop-up screen will appear asking if you want to allow multiple documents to be downloaded. Select “allow” or “yes” to download the additional documents. You can access these documents anytime your permit is valid and print them as many times as you like.
