





- Reconfiguration of Entrance and Traffic Circulation
- Upgraded Camping Experience

# Campground Addition Bubble Diagram




- Improves vehicle circulation within the park boundaries
- Allows for larger pull-through and back-in RV spaces with 3-point hook ups
- Provides new bathhouse to serve additional RV camping
- Provides overflow parking

# Campground Expansion Bubble Diagram



- Maintains connectivity with existing campground
- Larger expansion geared towards the long-term future of the campground
- Provides an additional exit from the park
- Provides an additional centrally located camp store
- Allows for larger pull-through and back in RV spaces with 3-point hook ups
- Locates new bathhouse to serve expansion area

# Campground Addition Schematic



- Campground Expansion – will go through detailed design
- Provides 32 pull-thru spaces
- 2 back-in spaces designed to accommodate equestrian camping
- RV space size is standardized and can accommodate larger campers
- All RV spaces will have 3-point hook ups (water, sewer, and electricity)
- Provides 50 overflow parking spaces
- New Bathhouse, including showers

# Campground Expansion Schematic



- Conceptual expansion only – no detailed design
- Provides 64 back-in, 44 pull-thru, and 8 pull-thru “buddy sites”
- 2 additional secluded equestrian camping sites
- Additional camp store with laundry and administrative services and a playground
- Maintains connectivity to existing campground and park trail network
- Improves traffic circulation and safety within the campground by providing an additional exit
